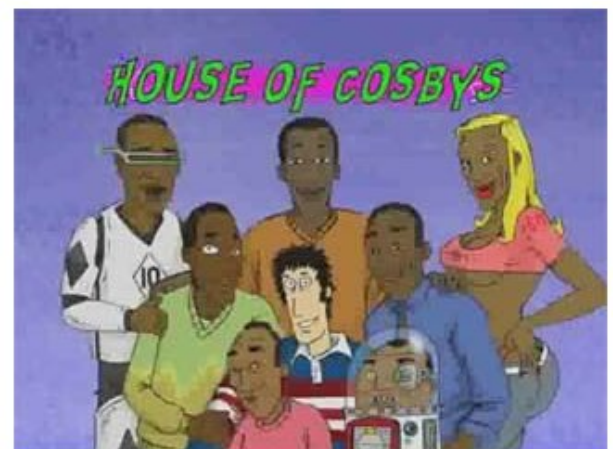
Final score: **Cosbys** pushed the spread, anything else didn't matter...

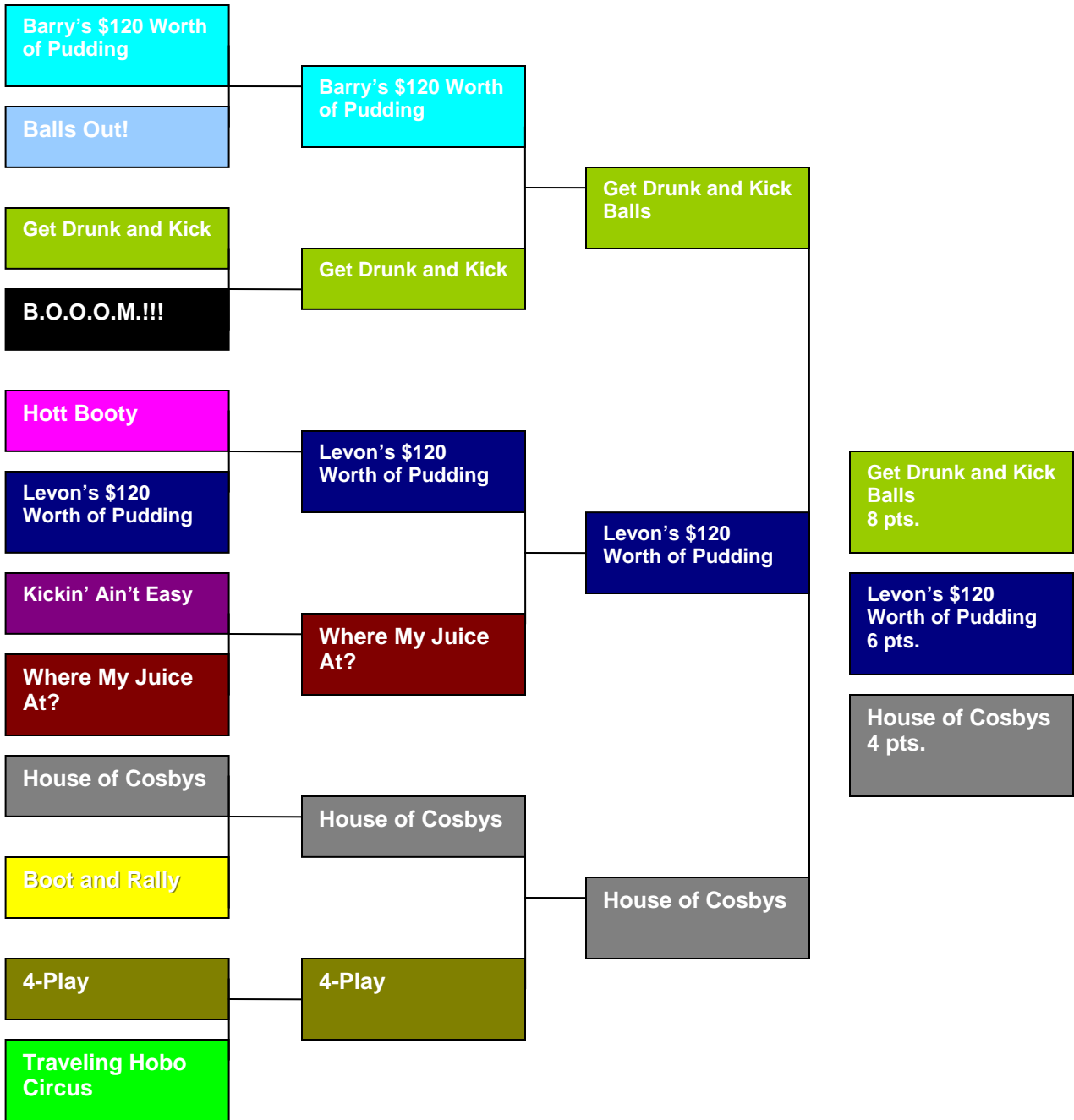

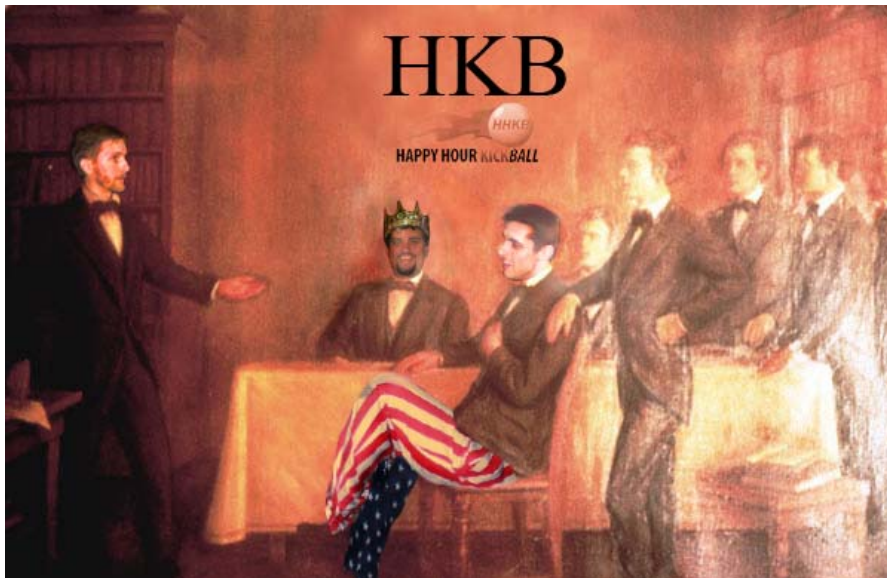

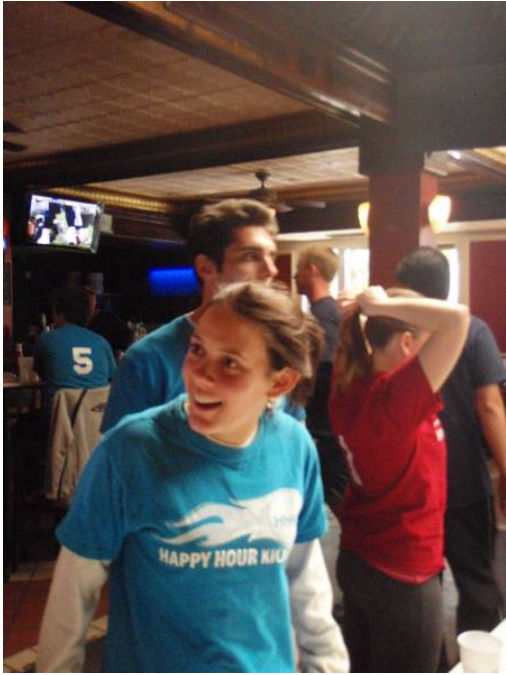
