Only really occur if you have less than 4 people, this will be very difficult to accomplish, so we don't think this should be an issue.

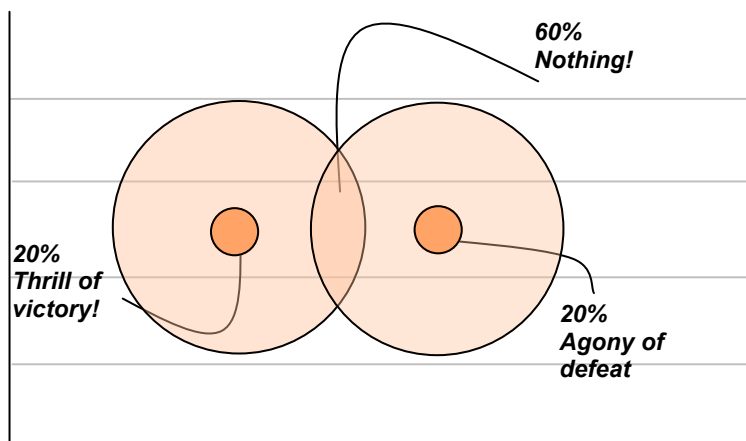

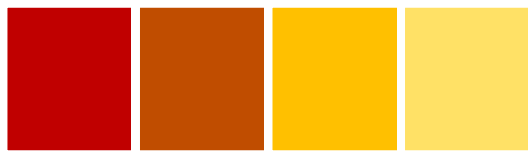

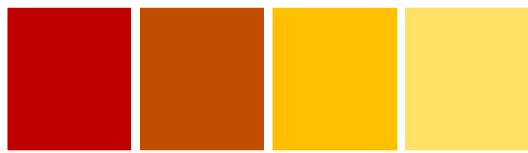
Close but not enough.

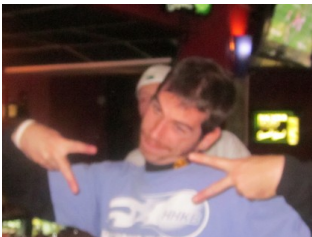

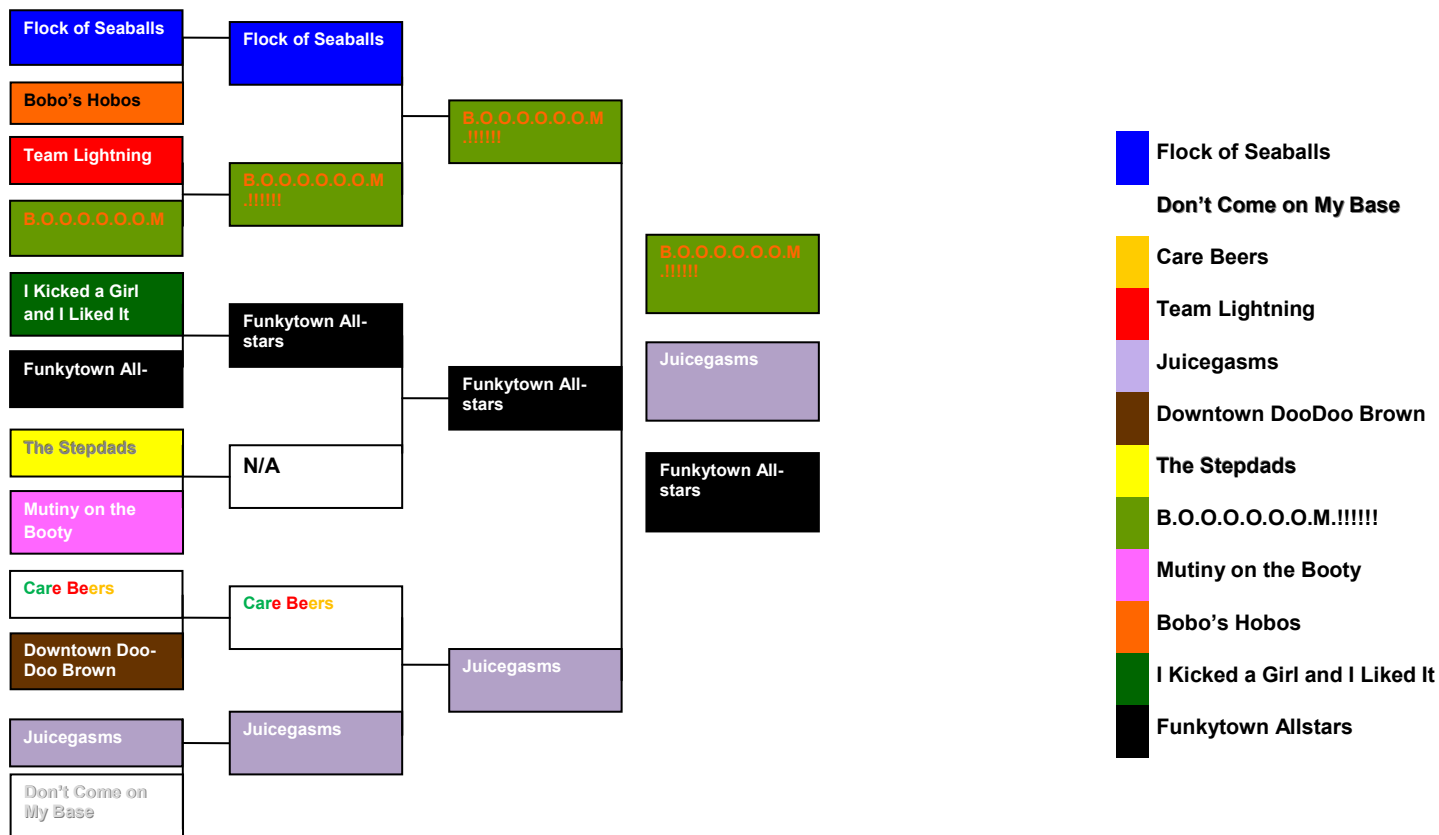
